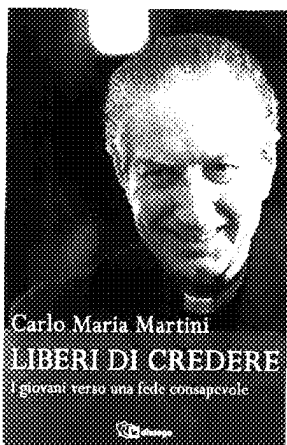

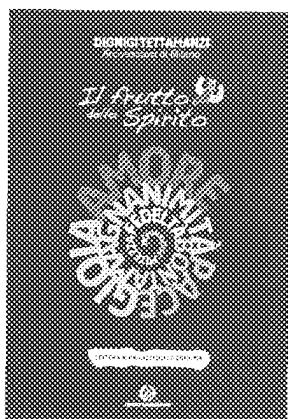

This is the question, posed by a twelve-year-old boy, to which the letter from Cardinal Tettamanzi is intended to reply. The letter is addressed to all the boys and girls who are preparing for Confirmation, even though "nobody can give you the truest and most important replies... These you can and must find for yourselves through that wonderful enthralling dialogue with the Lord which is prayer". However the Archbishop of Milan does indicate a path to follow, in the words of Saint Paul in his Letter to the Galatians (5, 22): "The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, temperance". not forgetting that in the seeds there is already, in some way, the fruit... from which the seeds themselves originate.

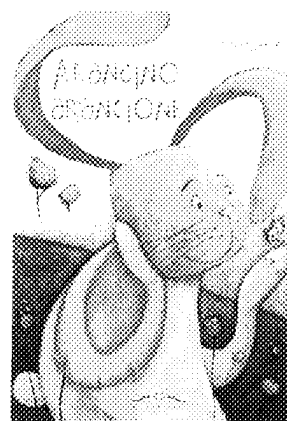

A group of about thirty girls, from 10 to 14 years of age, write short messages in a virtual diary in which they reveal the typical problems of their age which torment them: family, friends, school, their relationship with their own body, their relationship with God, the dangers of the Internet, parents' divorce, the discovery of sexuality. The diary is not just a listening device, it also understands, prods, suggests and, with a tone which is gentle and stimulating but never patronising, it guides the girls towards the path of personal maturity. In this way it turns into a friend, always wished for and always available, but also knowing how to stay in its place, closed and silent, when it is not sought. This book could also be an excellent gift for Confirmation.
